Nessij X Think Tanger X Mouhit Space

The Tunis - Tanger Cross-Residency Program invites one artist, curator or researcher from Tunisia and one from Morocco to engage in a collaborative research-based residency exploring questions related to urban life and connections between the cities of Tunis and Tanger.

The program focuses on developing dialogue and creative exchange between the two regions through artistic practices that address urbanism and city-making.

Artists are invited to reflect on the urban and social dynamics of Tunis and Tanger, considering the ties, common ground (and perhaps disruptions) that bind the two cities.

For the residency, the artist will receive:

- Logistical support and networking opportunities coordinated by Mouhit Space
- Accommodation and workspace at Mouhit Space
- A project support budget up to 500 EUR
- A total per diem budget of 300 EUR
- A round-trip flight ticket Morocco-Tunis

Eligibility

The residency in Tunis is open for artists, curators and researchers working and residing in Morocco. All artistic disciplines are welcome, provided the proposed project connects to the theme of urban life and the relationship between Tunis and Tanger. Applicants must demonstrate a strong interest in collaborative research and a clear plan for engaging with the residency's theme.

About Nessij

Nessij, which means “web” in Arabic, is a collective founded in 2023 by a group of Tunisian artists and art workers who aim to support and promote the Tunisian artistic and cultural scene internationally. Nessij aims to encourage the circulation of artists, their works and the country's cultural workers, as well as to strengthen exchange and solidarity between scenes, and particularly within the South.

About Mouhit Space

Mouhit is an art space based in Tunis which supports creative practitioners at all levels of their career by offering a convivial environment for reflection, artistic experimentation, and self development.

About Think Tanger

Think Tanger is a cultural and artistic platform based in Tanger, Morocco. It focuses on urban research, design, and social engagement, exploring the city's rapid urban transformations and their impact on communities. Through Artistic residencies, workshops, exhibitions, publications, and urban tours, Think Tanger Fosters creative and critical conversations about the city's development. The platform collaborates with local and international artists, architects, designers, and researchers to promote alternative ways of thinking about urban spaces. This first residency is open to artists, researchers or curators living and working in Tunisia and will be hosted by Think Tanger in Tanger in June of 2025.
